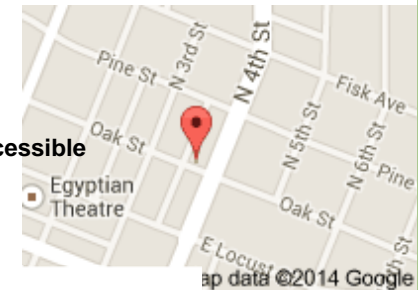

How do I sign up?

Complete a registration form. Sign up no later than the Friday before the class begins. All classes begin June 24. Most kids' classes run for 2-3 days from 1-2 p.m.

What does it cost?

Nothing. Classes are free to all lunch participants.

What is expected?

1. Registration for each class closes the Friday before the class begins. Your registration form must be turned in by 2 p.m. that day.
2. Children must arrive & sign in to the assigned classroom by 1:00 each day of the class and must stay for the entire session. (NOTE: a few classes begin at 12:45.) Latecomers will NOT be admitted. Participation each day of the class is strongly encouraged.
3. Parents must provide an emergency number at which they can be reached during the session. Pre-school parents are asked to remain at the church other than during Vacation Bible School.
4. Call the church at 815-756-6301 no later than 11:30 a.m., or notify Vicki if your child will not be attending a class for which he is registered that day .

What can I do while my child is in class?

Join one of our adult classes or groups, volunteer in the lunch room, or visit with others in the lunch room.
