### Welcome Parents and Happy Campers

...to Stellar VBS! During the week of **JULY 10-14**, we are going to discover what it means to shine Jesus' light! We are heading to **Walcamp**, an outdoor Christian Education facility, to experience this unique VBS.

- Preschool children, ages 4 & 5, are invited to join us for 1/2 days Monday-Thursday, and a full day on Friday for our Preschool Program. Busing will be available for preschoolers **TO camp only (Mon-Thurs)** but will bus preschoolers back to the new church building on Friday. \*\*Note information about Friday below in the "NEW THIS YEAR" box. Preschool parents will need to arrange their own pick-up at camp Monday-Thursday.

- We understand that some 5 year olds are able to participate in a full-day program. If you feel that your 5 year old camper can stay at camp the entire day, you are welcome to register them in the full-day program.

- Full-day program is open to those entering first grade through seventh grade as campers (and kindergarteners if able to attend all day), and eighth grade through college for youth leaders.

- Our family picnic is on Friday- preschoolers and parents are welcome to join everyone for lunch and stay the afternoon for fun and games at the new church building. ### **Busing Information**

 $\rightarrow$  Those taking the bus will need to be dropped off at the **church's north parking lot** at **8:40 a.m.** (Church address is **317** North 4th Street) All children and youth must check in with the VBS volunteer. Buses will depart at 8:45 a.m.

 $\rightarrow$  The bus will return to the church at 3:15 p.m. for elementary and youth every day (and Friday for preschoolers.)

→ Please be sure to mark on your child's registration form whether or not your child will be taking the bus, and include any specific information/instructions for bus riding (ex. Not taking the bus on certain days.)

 $\rightarrow$  Only people listed on the registration form will be authorized to pick up your child. If a person is not listed on the registration form, the person will not be allowed to pick up your child without direct notification from the child's parent. Please contact the director of any pick up changes. We reserve the right to check ID's of people that we do not know.

### New This Year

We are so excited to change our routine a bit this year on Friday. Friday, campers and youth will be dropped of at the church in the morning like normal to go to camp, but we will be taking the bus back to THE NEW CHURCH BUILDING, arriving at 12:30 p.m., and have our family picnic there. Families are invited to meet us at the new building for the picnic, stay for the afternoon for games if they would like, and we will finish our day at 3:15. If you are unable to attend the family picnic or cannot stay the entire afternoon, you will be picking up your campers at the new church building at 3:15. If your camper/youth is not taking the bus throughout the week, please contact Nancy so that we can make arrangements for busing to the new building and for pick up on Friday.

### COMMUNICATION

- REMIND APP—You will need to sign up for the Remind App to receive daily reminders during the week of VBS. To register for this handy and convenient service, text the number 81010, then in message type @umcv This is our main way to communicate throughout the week of VBS, so please register to receive text notices. You do not need to download the app to receive text messages.
- If weather does NOT permit us to be outside for camp, a text through **Remind** will be sent with information about how we will proceed with the day's activities.

### **REGISTRATION INFORMATION**

- Included with this mailing is a family <u>Registration Form</u>.
- If your camper is a youth volunteer (eighth grade through college age) an extra form is included regarding registration for *CREW LEADER TRAINING*. Please include Crew Leader Training form when returning the registration form.
- Please make sure you read through and fill out all the information included, then sign and return Registration Form, Information Packet Signature Form, and Youth Training Form.
- Please be sure to mark on the Registration form if your family would like to receive a music CD from this year's VBS.
- Early Bird Registration –You will get a \$5 discount per camper/youth if you register on or before May 31st.
- **Final deadline** for registration is **JUNE 23.** This is an earlier deadline than previous years, so please be sure to get your forms in early. Spots cannot be guaranteed if forms are received after June 23rd.

### **ONLINE REGISTRATION is OPEN**

- to register and pay, go to www.firstumc.net and click on the VBS picture on the slide show; this will take you to the registration and payment form.

- to only make a payment online, go to www.firstumc.net and scroll down to the bottom of the page and click "e-giving", from there click on "choose a fund" box and scroll down to Vacation Bible School—please submit a hard copy of registration form to the main office.

# What Should Campers Wear and Bring Daily

- Appropriate clothes for outside and weather (we are outside all day)
- Camp t-shirt (issued on Day 1, then wear every day thereafter)
- Socks and Gym Shoes (NO OPEN TOE SHOES OR SANDALS)
- \*\*\*Water bottle with camper's name on it \*\*\*
- Sunscreen and bug repellant should be applied before coming to camp, and brought to camp to reapply in the afternoon
- Swimsuit and towel—we don't swim everyday but water games are played throughout the week
- A healthy, non-perishable lunch
- A backpack

# What NOT to Bring

- Toys/video games
- Glass bottles
- Anything that can be broken, stolen, lost, or of value
- Cell Phones We understand many kids of all ages have their own phones, however phone usage is not allowed once campers/youth are on the bus to camp until they are off the return bus at church.

# First Aid, Medical Emergency, and Health Policies

If your child is injured, we will take the necessary steps to obtain medical care. The steps may include, but not limited to:

- Administer general first aid
- Contacting parent(s)/guardian(s) or emergency contact
- Contacting emergency response personnel and/or transporting to a hospital
- A First UMC volunteer will accompany the child to the hospital until a parent/guardian arrives

Camper/Youth attending Vacation Bible School, must be free of the following illness or symptoms for at least 24 hours:

~ Fever (without fever reducing medicines) ~ Any unexplained rash

~ Any contagious skin or eye infections

### **Medication at Camp**

~ Colored nasal drainage

If your child requires medication during camp hours, please call the Director of Christian Education at 815-756-6301 prior to camp for arrangements. Please DO NOT send any medications with the camper in his/her backpack or lunch; an adult VBS volunteer will be available at bus drop-off to give the medicine to. If your child arrives at camp without sunscreen and/or bug repellant, the adult unit leader will apply it to your child upon arrival at camp.

### Videos/Photographs

As a program participant of First UMC Vacation Bible School, your child may be filmed/photographed during his/her activities at camp. We may use these videos/photos periodically in our services, newsletters, website or other publications. If you have any objections to the use of your child's video/photo, please indicate your objections on the registration form.

#### **VBS D**iscipline

At First United Methodist Church Vacation Bible School, we aim to teach and model the love of God towards each other while providing a fun and safe environment for children of all ages. Therefore, we give encouragement freely and use criticism sparingly. In order to do this, the leadership team has established a set of rules. We ask you, the parents and guardians, to read the following rules with your child and encourage your child to abide by them:

- 1. Follow directions the first time they are given.
- 2. Talk in an appropriate, respectful manner.
- 3. Respect Unit, Station, and Crew leaders as well as Walcamp staff.
- 4. Be considerate of others' feelings and belongings.
- 5. Name-calling, teasing, or the use of any inappropriate language is never acceptable.
- 6. There will be no hitting, kicking, or fighting.

7. Abide by all safety rules.

Failure to abide by these rules will result in an initial warning, and depending on the violation, followed by these consequences:

1. A first violation will result in a warning and an individual conference with VBS leadership.

- 2. A second violation will result in a conference between the VBS Director and the parent/guardian.
- 3. In the event of further violation, the participant will be sent home for the remainder of the week.

Every incident will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis and consequences will be determined by the severity of an incident. Suspension will only take place in the most extreme cases and at the discretion of the VBS Director.
